

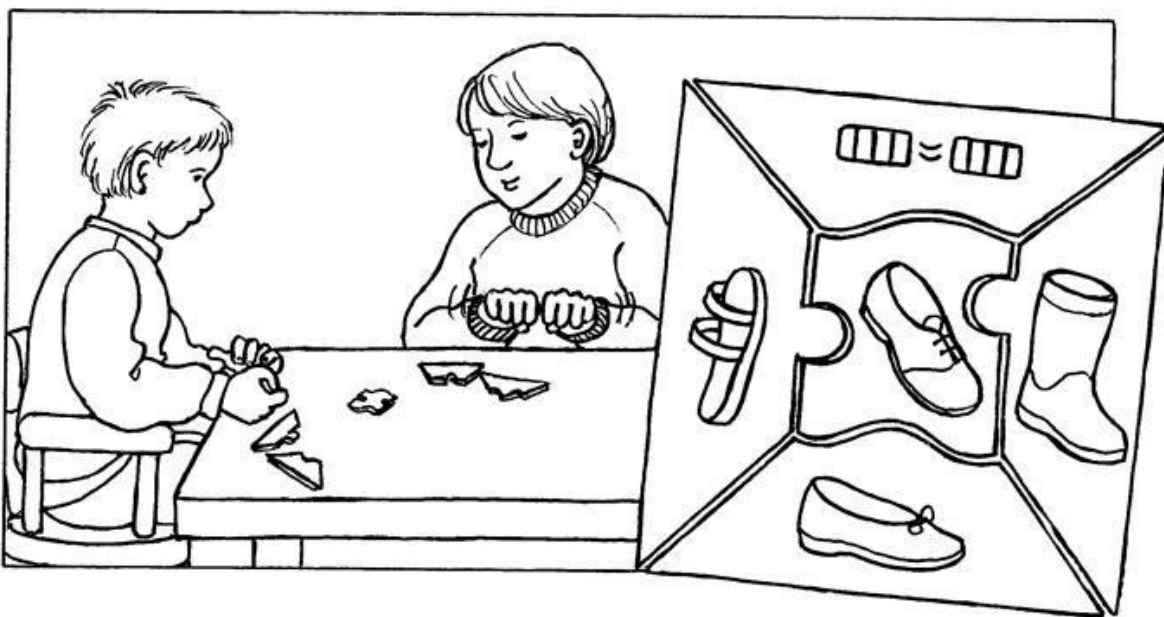

Language Team



What is the Mobile Language Team?

The Mobile Language Team (MLT) works as a support resource for preschool children with language difficulties. The team consists of one special education teacher and two speech and language therapists. The special education teachers work directly with the children at their respective preschool and also guides the preschool staff in their work.



What does language difficulties mean?

It means difficulties in one or more areas of language learning, i.e. speech sounds, grammar, vocabulary, comprehension and communication.



Who qualifies for support?

In order to receive support from MLT the child needs to be between 2,5 and 6 years old, and attend a preschool in the municipality of Svalöv. The child's language must be assessed by a speech therapist at a hospital. As a caregiver you can get in contact with a hospital directly or get a referral from your child health care center (BVC).



Application process

The speech therapist at the hospital fills out an application form together with the caregivers. When MLT receives the application it's decided if support from MLT is a suitable option for the child. If that is the case the caregivers are invited to an enrollment meeting with the preschool and MLT.

Aims of the Mobile Language Team:

- support the child's development of speech, language and communication
- increase the child's faith in its own ability to use speech and language
